



PISA MEETS TASHKENT: A JOURNEY BETWEEN GEOSCIENCES AND CULTURES (21-29/10/2023)

A comparative procedure is announced for the year 2023, for the selection of 12 students from the University of Pisa to participate in the project "*Pisa Meets Tashkent: a journey between Geosciences and Cultures.*"

Requirements for admission to the call for applications:

1) be enrolled in the a.y. 2022/2023 in one of the following degree programs:

- Master's Degree in Scienze e Tecnologie Geologiche;
- Master's degree in Scienze Ambientali;
- Master's degree in Exploration and Applied Geophysics;

2) Have acquired, in the university career, adequate skills in the field of Geological and Environmental Sciences;

3) Specify in the application why they want to participate by attaching their university curriculum vitae with a list of examinations taken related to the degree program they are attending and a motivational letter (3000 characters including spaces);

4) Have a passport with at least three months remaining validity as of October 2023.

The application will not be evaluated in case the student:

1) enrolled in the current degree program in a year before 2020/2021;

2) is not in good standing with the payment of tuition fees.

Applications for the competition must be submitted, **by 1:00 p.m. on September 9th, 2023**, exclusively by filling out the form at the following address:

In case of more than 12 applications, a selection based on the following criteria will be done:

(a) weighted average of the examinations taken in the degree program the student is enrolled in;

(b) consistency of the academic course with the aims of the project.

For points a and b, the maximum score is 5;

(c) the score obtained at the interview. During the interview, the motivations for which the candidate wants to join the project will be asked.

For point c the max score is 5;



(d) priority will be given to those who have NOT participated in previous initiatives funded under the special projects for teaching.

The following two files must be uploaded in the application form:

- Curriculum vitae in Italian or English;
- Short letter (max 3000 characters, including spaces) supporting the reasons for the application.

The selection committee is composed as follows: Dr. Silvia Fornasaro, Dr. Pier Paolo Giacomoni, Prof. Francesca Meneghini, Prof. Adriano Ribolini, and Ms. Giuseppina Siniscalco.

The interviews will be held on September 13th, 2023, from 11 a.m. at the Department of Earth Sciences at Via Santa Maria, 53 (in case it will be necessary to conduct interviews in a telematic session, the link of the meeting will be previously communicated to participants via e-mail).

The ranking of the winners will be published on the home page of the Department's website and the winners will be notified exclusively at the university mailbox.
